

# **Special Function Keys:**


Your Keypad has a set of special function keys located underneath the LCD screen. For the name and description of these keys, please see the chart below:

Name	Button	Description
Volume Up	Ľ <b>+</b> ℂ_⊅	When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to increase the volume of your speakers.
Volume Down		When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to decrease the volume of your speakers.
Play / Pause		When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to play (or pause) the current track.
Mute	(L)	When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to mute the speakers.
BS	BS ()	This key functions as the <backspace> key on your keyboard.</backspace>
Previous Track	( <u>H4</u> )	When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to go back to the previous track on the current play list.
Next Track	<b>₩</b>	When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to proceed to the next track on the current play list.
Stop		When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and media player is active, click this button to stop the player.
Send	Send	When your Keypad is in "Keypad" mode and a writing editor (e.g. Microsoft® Word) is active, click this button to paste the numbers shown on the LCD screen into the editor.
Mode	Mode	Press this button to switch between CALC (calculator) and KEYPAD (10-keys pad) mode.


### Installation:

**NOTE**: The pictures shown in the User's Manual are for demonstration purposes only. Your computer or product may look slightly different.


1. Remove the **Battery Compartment Cover** on the back of your Keypad, and install the enclosed battery into your Keypad following the battery orientation guide in the battery bay, and then slide the cover back onto your Keypad until it securely locks.




2. Press the **Battery Compartment Cover Latch** and slide the cover off your Mouse. Install the enclosed batteries into your Mouse following the battery orientation guide in the battery bay, and then slide the cover back onto your Mouse until it securely locks.



- 3. Turn on your computer and wait for it to load.
- 4. Plug the USB Receiver into an available USB port on your computer.
- 5. Turn on the power switch on the back of your Keypad , your Keypad will establish a connection with the receiver and will be ready to be used. If a connection is not established, there might be a high level of surrounding interference, press the connect button on the USB Receiver, , and then press the connect button on the bottom of your Keypad f.



6. Turn on the power switch on the bottom of your Mouse • , your Mouse will establish a connection with the receiver and will be ready to be used. If a connection is not established, there might be a high level of surrounding interference, press the Connect button on the USB Receiver , , and then press the Connect button on the bottom of your Mouse f.



- 7. Your computer will detect your Keypad and Mouse, and the necessary drivers will be installed automatically.
- 8. Your Keypad and Mouse are now ready to be used.
